

CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER

INHIBITED ACID CLEANER

Form: Liquid **Color:** Green **Odor:** Acid

- Contains powerful hydrochloric acid, wetting and penetrating agents and inhibitors to protect metal surfaces from the acid.
- Active ingredients bubble and fizz away concrete deposits.
- Also dissolves scale, lime, rust, mineral deposits, Portland Concrete, plaster and mortar.

CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER actually dissolves concrete carbonates, yet it won't harm metal tools or equipment. For light deposits, it can be diluted with equal parts of water. Heavy concrete build-up may require an application of **CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER** at full strength. After leaving the solution set for a few minutes, little physical effort is necessary to remove concrete. Simply use a wire brush or scrub off any remaining residue. A simple water rinse leaves equipment looking clean and new.

Other **CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER** uses . . .

Ammonia Neutralizer

Apply full strength.

Boat & Buoy Cleaner

Apply full strength.

Coil Cleaner

Use at a 1 to 8 dilution.

Rust Remover

Apply full strength.

Dairy Tank Cleaner

Use at a 1 to 5 dilution.

Tile & Grout Cleaner

Use at a 1 to 4 dilution.

Brick Cleaner

Use at a 1 to 3 dilution.

Pool Conditioner

Apply full strength to pool and test pH

Ice Machine De-limer

Use at 1 to 15 dilution.

Sewage Acid Treatment

Use full strength

DIRECTIONS: Apply **CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER** full strength to remove heavy deposits, using a stiff bristle brush. Use plastic pails to carry or store **CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER**. For light deposits dilute with equal parts of water. Rinse and flush liberally with water after cleaning.

This formula is also formulated for cleaning, etching and bleeding concrete, masonry, brick and flagstone. **CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER** cleans and etches old concrete floors to provide the best surface preparation for maximum paint bonding and neutralizes alkali present in new concrete.

TO USE AS A CLEANER AND ETCHER: For heavily soiled concrete, sweep floor to remove loose soil. Scrub the floor with tar remover or water soluble non-flammable cleaner to remove heavy soil or grease and oil deposits and rinse. Dilute 1 gallon of **CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER** with up to 5 gallons of water depending upon age and condition of floor. Scrub this solution on the next area to be cleaned. When bubbling and fizzing stop, cleaning is finished. Rinse thoroughly by hosing or flushing with clear water.

DEMO/TIP: Apply **CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER** full strength to remove heavy deposits and use a stiff bristle brush to loosen the deposits before flushing away with water under pressure. To remove light deposits, dilute **CONCRETE TRUCK CLEANER** 1:1 with water.
