

## **Graffiti & Paint Remover**

- Removes various paints (including enamel), ink and permanent marker.
- Ideal for **non-pours** surfaces including phone booths, stainless steel, bus stops, lockers, billboards, glass, road signs, wall tiles, desks, trains, aluminum siding and lamp posts.
- Contains **no amyl acetate** or **methylene chloride**, making towels safe to hands. Formula is non-toxic, non-flammable, non-hazardous, biodegradable and odourless.

Pre-moistened with an effective cleaning formula, **GRAFFITI TOWELS** remove various paints (including enamel), ink and even permanent marker with just a few strokes of a single towel. They are perfect for almost all non-porous surfaces. To aid in cleaning, each towel is made from an abrasive yet non-scratching fabric that helps lift away heavy marks. The cleaning formula in **GRAFFITI TOWELS** is non-toxic, non-flammable and non-hazardous. Best of all the formula contains no amyl acetate or methylene chloride, making them safe to handle. In addition, **GRAFFITI TOWELS** are odourless and do not give off any nauseous fumes.

## **Directions:**

DIRECTIONS FOR DISPENSING: Remove lid. Pull up the towel at the centre of the roll by the corner and thread it through the 'X' from the underside of the lid. Replace lid onto container and close hinged cap to prevent towels from drying out. When removing a towel, pull at a 90 angle until towel tears away at perforation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use gloves provided to protect hands from paint and ink residue. Unfold a towel and lightly scrub in circular motion to begin dissolving paint and graffiti. Wipe up any remaining residue with a clean cloth. Repeat these steps if necessary.

NOTE: When using **GRAFFITI TOWELS** on a pre-painted surface, initially test in an inconspicuous area to make sure paint is not removed along with the graffiti. **GRAFFITI TOWELS** may attack certain plastics.
